

BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT



- You will receive an invitation for your vaccine appointment by text message (SMS)
- The message will indicate the time, date and location of your appointment
- Please bring your PPS number and photo ID (e.g. passport, driving licence / Public Services Card). You will not receive a vaccine without photo ID
- You should wear a loose fitting or short sleeved top as the vaccine will be administered to your upper arm
- Plan to arrive 10 minutes before your appointment and wait in your car until 5 minutes before your appointment
- Please dress for the weather as you may need to queue outside

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



- Wear a mask when you arrive and for the duration of the appointment
- Enter the site through main entrance gates on Galway Road
- If driving you will be directed by security staff to a car park
- At the entrance to the car park you will be asked by security staff for your name to verify that you are scheduled for a vaccination appointment
- Security staff will also conduct a wellness check, to confirm you do not have any COVID-19 symptoms
- Disabled parking spaces are available for permit holders
- Park your car and make your way to the entrance which is signposted in yellow
- If you have travelled with a companion, they should remain in the car unless they need to attend with you in exceptional circumstances

INSIDE THE CENTRE



- There may be a small queue outside the entrance, please ensure physical distancing of 2 meters if queuing
- Please use hand sanitiser located at the entrance
- When it's your turn, go inside the building and you will be directed to a reception desk to check in
- Reception staff will confirm your appointment, your name, date of birth and your PPS number
- You will then be directed to a numbered booth to receive your vaccine
- A vaccinator will be waiting for you inside the booth
- The vaccinator will ask you some questions to confirm your eligibility for a vaccine and will administer your vaccine to your upper arm
- You will be given your vaccination record and will be asked to take a seat in the observation area for 15 minutes
- You should keep the vaccination record safe as you will need to bring it with you for your second appointment
- Once the 15 minutes have passed you can leave the observation area via the exit door at the side of the room. Please use hand sanitiser at the exit door
- Follow the directions to exit the site as advised by security staff
