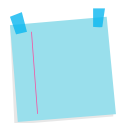

# BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT



- This centre is operating walk-in clinics, you do not need to make an appointment to attend the vaccination centre
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and parental consent must be provided
- Please bring your PPS number and photo ID (e.g. passport, driving licence / public services card, Garda age card or school ID).
- You will not receive a vaccine without photo ID
- If you are coming for a second dose of vaccine bring your vaccination record card
- You should wear a loose fitting or short sleeved top as the vaccine will be administered to your upper arm
- Please dress for the weather as you may need to queue outside

## WHEN YOU ARRIVE



- Wear a mask when you arrive and for the duration of the appointment
- Enter the site through main entrance
- Park your car and make your way to the entrance at the front of the Centre
- Disabled parking spaces are available
- At the entrance to the Vaccination Centre security staff will ask some COVID-19 screening questions
- If you have travelled with a companion, they should remain in the car unless they need to attend with you in exceptional circumstances

## INSIDE THE CENTRE



- There may be a queue outside the entrance, please ensure physical distancing of 2m if queueing
- Please use hand sanitiser located at the entrance
- When it's your turn to go inside the building you will be directed to a reception desk to check in
- Reception staff will confirm your name, date of birth and your PPS number
- You will then be directed to a booth to receive your vaccine
- A vaccinator will be waiting for you inside the booth
- The vaccinator will ask you some questions to confirm your eligibility for a vaccine and will administer your vaccine to your upper arm
- You will be given your vaccination record and will be asked to take a seat in the observation area for 15 minutes
- You should keep the vaccination record safe as you will need to bring it with you if you require a second vaccination appointment
- Once the 15 minutes have passed you can leave the observation area via the exit door at the side of the Centre
